III. Observation

The gender expert, Mrs. Nguyen Thi Minh Huong, head of Information-Education-Communication Department of Vietnam Woment's Union who was responsible for this training workshop. She helped the participants to understand the overview of gender issue, especially gender in higher education.

The result of the Gender training workshop is an essensial factor on building HUNRE curricula that is suitable for HUNRE characteristics; Make sure that female and male students are equal in benifitting from the education; Regard to shorten the gap between man and women in work as well as management.
